## Our Green Credentials

**Here at Penmaenuchaf Hall, we take care to incorporate into our activities measures to reduce our impact on the environment whenever possible. Below are some of the steps we have taken already and some other avenues we continue to explore. If you have any suggestions, please let us know!**

- We use energy saving bulbs throughout the hotel and encourage staff and guests to switch off lights when not required.
- We recycle all kitchen waste, paper products, glass and plastic as well as minimising the amount of waste paper produced in the offices.
- We have replaced our boiler with a more energy efficient one.
- We use locally sourced ingredients from regional suppliers to keep down the carbon footprint of our menu, and the developing kitchen garden will in time provide fruit, vegetables and herbs for the hotel, at zero food miles.
- The honey used in the kitchen and sold from our gift shop is produced from hives in the grounds, expertly tended by local beekeepers.
- Many of our locally based staff take advantage of the great outdoors and walk, run or cycle to and from the hotel to work.
- We encourage guests to leave their car at home and let us help them arrange to make their journey to the hotel by train, or once checked in, leave their vehicle in our car park while they explore the area using the cycle network or public transport links.
- Guests are asked to help us minimise the amount of laundry the hotel produces by letting us know when their bathroom towels need changing, thus avoiding unnecessary washing.
- We have an electric vehicle charging point available free of charge for guests staying at the hotel.
- All the wood you see fuelling our roaring log fires during the cooler months comes from trees in the grounds.
- We use only paper straws in drinks prepared in the hotel bar.
