We welcome your pets to Penmaenuchaf Hall on the condition that the following guide lines are respected:

- *Owners of pets are requested to use the allocated entrances and exits of the hotel.*
- *Please do not take your pet through the hotel corridors.*
- *Pets must not be left in the bedroom alone unless in a pet cage.*
- *Pets may be fed on the first floor exit but not in the bedroom.*
- *Please do not allow your pet to jump on the beds or on the furniture.*
- *During inclement weather, pets must be dried thoroughly prior to entering the hotel and bedroom. We can supply towels for this purpose.*
- *Dogs are permitted in the hotel gardens and grounds on a lead.*
- *Owners are respectfully asked to dispose of any mess in the brown bin made by their pet in the interest of hygiene as the grounds are used by other guests and children.*
- *Pets are allowed in the main hall and can sit by the fire with their owners. They are not allowed in any other public rooms.*
- *Any damage caused by pets will be charged for.*
- *Please note that we are in a rural area and surrounded by farm land where there are sheep and other livestock. Please keep to the Country Code.*
- *A charge from £20 per night will be levied on each pet staying at the hotel*
